MAY is Older American's Month!

Older American's Month was established in 1963 and only 17 million living American's had reached their 65th birthdays. Many lived in poverty and had few programs to help them meet their needs. President John F. Kennedy designated May as "Senior Citizens Month". President Jimmy Carter in 1980 changed the title from "Senior Citizen's Month" to "Older American's Month". In Louisiana, Older American's Month is celebrated with picnics, health fairs, fish fry events, crawfish boils and senior dances. Join us in celebrating Older American's Month. Portion Control is the key to obtaining and maintaining a desirable weight. The three methods of eating the correct amount of food are: Measuring the food, using the fist as identification of a portion size and finally the



"Healthy Plate" or "My Plate". USDA produced "My Plate" which may be used as a method of measuring the food by filling the plate according to what is eaten. Approximately, one third of the plate is filled with Vegetables, another third is filled with Grains, one sixth of the plate is allowed for the protein source and the final sixth is for fruit.
